Walk Safely on Campus
The University aims to provide safe movement through the campus at all hours for staff, students and visitors. A system of Walksafe pathways has been identified and highlighted in maroon on this Campus Map. Walksafe pathways are well lit, clearly visible and signposted pathways that address the main activity nodes on campus. Help posts are being installed at Walksafe path junction points, and all main foyers of major buildings have phones that connect to Security.
