Canada—a global centre of excellence in research and education.

The Vanier Canada Graduate Scholarships (Vanier CGS) program attracts and retains world-class doctoral students to Canadian universities by supporting individuals who demonstrate strong leadership skills and a high standard of scholarly achievement in graduate studies in health, natural sciences, engineering, humanities and social sciences.

This program provides 500 Canadian and international doctoral students with highly prestigious scholarships valued at \$50,000 per year for three years.

Students wishing to be considered for a Vanier CGS must be nominated by the Canadian university to which they are applying for doctoral studies.

International students are advised to contact the Canadian university at which they plan to study as early as possible. Students should indicate their interest in the Vanier CGS program to departmental faculty, or to the university’s graduate studies office. Vanier scholarships are awarded after a competitive, two-stage merit review process.

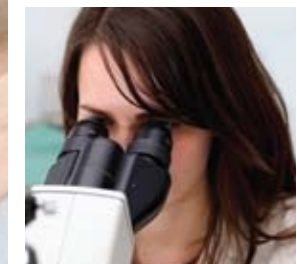
